
## SickKids Short External Length CVAD Securement with Clik-Fix® caringsafely

CVAD Securement devices are used to stabilize and prevent CVAD dislodgement. The CVAD dressing change procedure with Clik-Fix<sup>®</sup> will vary depending on when the securement device needs to be applied. This resource will review the application of Clik-Fix<sup>®</sup> for a CVAD with a *short external length*.


CVADs that have a short external length *cannot be looped* under the dressing. Select the appropriately sized IV Advanced Tegaderm<sup>™</sup> dressing<sup>\*</sup>. Remember to select the appropriately sized Clik-Fix<sup>®</sup> based on the French size of the CVAD.



Secure the CVAD wings using the universal *chevron method* of the Clik-Fix<sup>®</sup> and place on the skin.



Place the *main dressing*, covering the insertion site and all or part of the Clik-Fix<sup>®</sup>.



Complete the dressing change by using the additional dressing tapes to cover any remaining exposed areas of the Clik-Fix® and any gaps in the dressing.

This will keep the securement straps in place and keep the Clik-Fix<sup>®</sup> clean.
